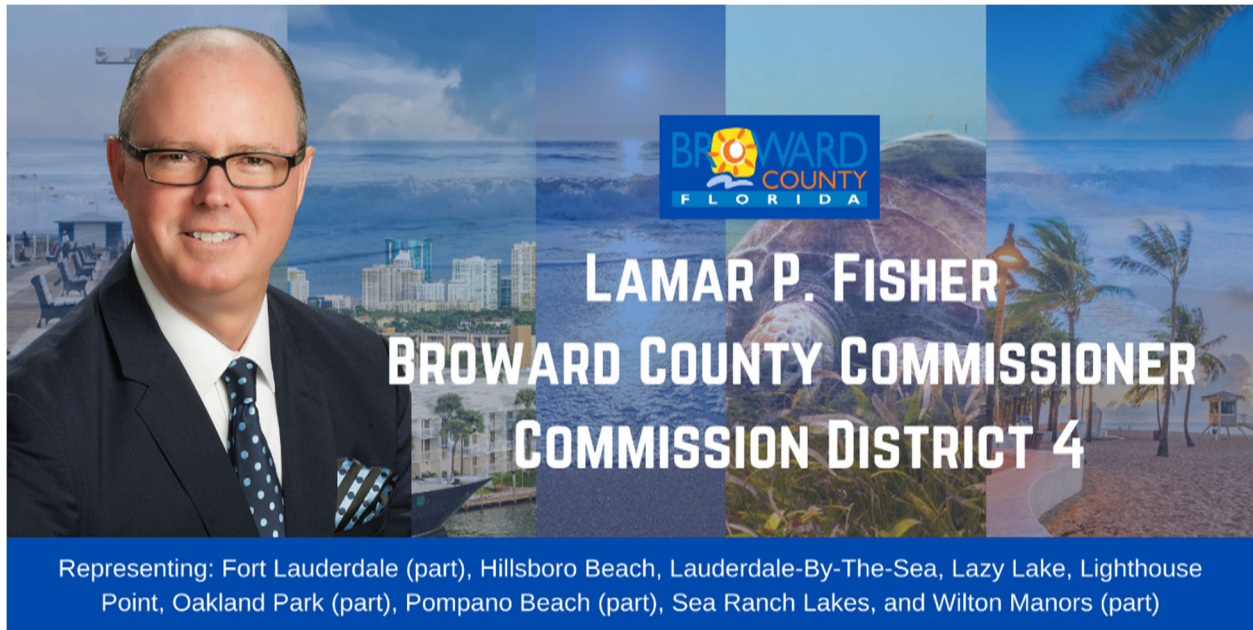

November 2026 Election



This November, voters get an opportunity to head to the polls. In Florida, residents must register by October 19, 2026, either online through the Florida Division of Elections website, by mail, or in person at a supervisor of elections office. Early voting is available from October 24 to October 31, 2026, at designated sites across Broward County. On Election Day, November 3, 2026, voters can cast ballots at their assigned polling place from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM EST. Voters are encouraged to check voter registrations by visiting [BrowardVotes.gov](https://www.browardvotes.gov). Through this website you can update your address, find your voting location and more.

I want to personally thank our Supervisor of Elections (SOE), Joe Scott, and his entire team for their incredible work leading up to, during and after election season. As an alternate

representative for the Canvassing Board, I've been able to go behind the scenes to see all the hard work the SOE team puts in every day to make sure they run fair, secure and transparent elections.
